

I am very proud to announce the results of the first two administrations of the TAKS test. The scores are a preliminary, with two more opportunities for the student to meet the passing standard.

Earlier last week, Bill Bechtol, Assistant Superintendent to Curriculum and Instruction, sent a report to campus principals with very **preliminary** results that included Limited English Proficient students and special population students whose scores are not counted in the Texas Accountability Rating System. This report was intended for campus personal for planning purposes only. Scores listed below are the scores that are reported to the state for accountability purposes. In addition, students not meeting the standard on the first administration will have two additional opportunities to meet the standard. We expect to have 100% of students in the 3rd grade and 5th grade to meet the passing standard in these areas after the second testing administration.

Final and official TAKS results and accountability ratings are released to the public in August.


3rd Grade Reading


